# Department for Education

The DfE have reported to us that the universal infants free school meals amendment to the Children and Families Bill was introduced and passed in the House of Lords. Following discussions over the past few days, they have been able to secure support from the Opposition and Cross-Benchers.

### Consideration of Free School Meals in Wales

On Wednesday, January 29<sup>th</sup>, the Welsh Assembly debated a motion tabled by the Liberal Democrats who called on the Government to spend the £62million they had calculated

they would be receiving from the Barnett consequential as a result of the Universal Free Infant School Meals policy on making sure Welsh children also get to enjoy the benefits of a healthy, nutritious meal during the school day.

While Plaid Cymru tabled two amendments to the motion and queried whether UFISM was the best use of the money, the Conservatives stated they planned to abstain from all votes on the motion, and the amendments, disagreeing vehemently with the policy.

In response, the Labour Minister for Education and Skills, Huw Lewis, said that he couldn't support the motion or the amendment and while he reiterated the Government's commitment to healthy eating and the work already done on free breakfasts, he stated that the Lib Dems had miscalculated the Barnett consequential, and the £26million they would be receiving was going to be channeled into other, more urgent and more pressing priorities.
