As you know LACA have teamed up with the Children's Food Trust and a range of partners to provide an **expert advice** service to schools as part of the government's School Food Plan.

Infant and primary schools
As part of the government's plan,
from the beginning of September
every state maintained school in
England will need to serve free
meals to all pupils in Reception,
Year 1 and Year 2. For many
schools this will be a huge
challenge – the new advice
service will give you all the help
you need.

All schools can access support online by emailing info@childrensfoodtrust.org.uk or by calling 0800 680 0080 - we'll help you to get ready to deliver free school meals for all infant pupils. For schools that need more support, there are a number of options including working with other schools, further telephone advice and face to face visits by specialist professional advisors.
